" Identity" Virtue #7

God's man finds his identity in what God says about him

"BELIEFS" Virtue #6

A man's beliefs determine his direction

Read [Romans 8:5-8](#)

What percentage of the time is your mindset set on things of the flesh versus things of the Spirit?

What issues do you need to address to increase your mindset of the Spirit?

"REPENTANCE" Virtue #5

God's man feels the full responsibility of sin and then makes a change without looking back

Identify one behavior you would like to change in someone you know. How does this behavior impact you.

Read [Matthew 4:17](#), [2 Chronicles 7:14](#), and [Luke 15:17-19](#)

What have been the hardest thoughts, behaviors, or attitudes for you to change or repent of?

"FAITH" Virtue #4

A man battles human fear with a reverent fear

Over the last few weeks, what issues consumed your mental energy? What about these situations generated human fear?

Read [Matthew 14:22-33](#)

In what area do you sense Jesus inviting you to step out in faith? What fears do you need to address?

"PRAYER" Virtue #3

A man of God talks to the God he loves

What is your prayer pattern?

If you could change anything about your prayer patterns, what would you change

What did Jesus teach his men was the right motive for prayer?

Read [Matthew 6:5-15](#)

What is the most significant prayers you have ever prayed?

Deploy the A.C.T.S. method of prayer (Adoration, Confession, Thanksgiving, and Supplication)

"ACTION" Virtue #2

A man of God fights apathy with action

What are the most prevalent sins you see taking down men in the home, work, or in churches today? Why?

Read [Genesis 3:1-13](#)

Where do you need to take action in your life?

"Receptivity" Virtue #1

A man of God is receptive to God's truth over a lifetime.

What is the one task you had to do last week that you were unreceptive to doing? What about the task, or you, made it objectionable?

Read today's text [Luke 8:4-15](#)

In what areas are you more receptive to the truth? What issues do you need to address?
